(CP Cable)—More than 1,000 German and Dutch Jews have been liberated from a concentration camp near this northern Netherlands town by the advance of the 2nd Canadian Division.

From Westerbork, 120,000 Jews have been sent during the last three years to camps in Poland and Czechoslovakia. The potential horror of that transshipment was replaced by the reality of freedom!

replaced by the reality of freedom when troops of the 8th Reconnaissance Regiment, of Shaunavon, Sask., and Medicine Hat, Alta, reached the camp Thursday.

Westerbork is the first Jewish concentration camp liberated by six months ago.
