## Son of Hamiltonian Dead at Hong Kong

Russell Poag, Missing More Than Year, Now Reported Killed in Action

Caledonia, Jan. 7.—Missing for over a year at Hong Kong, Cpl. Russell Poag, son of Samuel Poag, of Hamilton, is officially reported killed in action at Hong Kong, according to ad-

vice from military headquarters at Ottawa last night to his sister, Mrs. Comer McCauley, at Caledonia.

Corporal Poag was born 36 years ago near Caledonia, and before enlisting he was a garage mechanic in Hamilton for 18 years.

He joined up at Hamilton Cpl. Russell Poag early in the war, and served in the Far East with the Quebec Regiment. Besides his father, and sister at Caledonia, he is also survived by two brothers, Maxwell, of Detroit, and Douglas, Stratford.
